



Prayer Space Report

Why?

An important aspect of Prayer Spaces is their ability to cultivate the relationship that exists between the school and local churches and Christians. Of course even having completed a successful Prayer Space, it is important to remain aware of this relationship and how you can continue to build and maintain it.

One such method is to provide the school with a report of the Prayer Space. We feel that this is important for a number of reasons.

/ Perhaps most importantly it shows the senior management of a school the impact that the Prayer Space has had in a quick but concise manner. Creating a Wordle that gives a visual representation of the frequency in which words are used by the young people can be particularly useful.

/ A second benefit to the school is that it provides them with proof that they are maintaining the spiritual development of their students, something specified in the National Curriculum.

/ Finally it shows the school that you (both personally and as a team) are dedicated to investing time and energy into the school. Providing a report helps supplement the ongoing commitment to, and contact with, the school.

Hopefully you too can see the benefits!

How?

This is the method that we would generally follow when completing a report. Please feel free to adapt and improve it as you see fit. You can write your own report from scratch or use and adapt our template on the following pages.

1/ Write a personal reflection of how you felt the Prayer Space went. This can perhaps include some choice quotes from students, summaries of a few particularly memorable conversations or incidents, etc. - basically anything that you think would be beneficial for the school to be made aware of.

2/ Write out a summary for each prayer activity, include a brief explanation of the area of prayer the children were asked to look at and a brief description of what the activity involved.

3/ Write out the children's responses for each different prayer activity (including feedback comments) in which written responses were given.

4/ Compile the report in a method similar to the template provided. You will need to add extra pages for all the different activities if using our template.
